BABY DEDICATION GUIDE

Matthew 19: 14 – "But Jesus said, Suffer little children, and forbid them not, to come unto me: for of such is the kingdom of heaven".

Dedication Ceremonies for Babies are conducted on the 1st Sunday of the Month, by prior appointment.

You are required to contact the Church Office at least six weeks in advance to arrange the date for the ceremony.

The Calivigny Gospel Hall welcomes all residents of the parish and surrounding areas to attend the Sunday Morning Services followed by the Dedication Service at **12:00 noon**.

There is no cost for this ceremony, but parents of the child and witnesses to the ceremony are required to observe the following regulations:

Regulations:

- 1. Women must be modestly attired, preferably a dress (no mini~skirts/low necklines)
- 2. Men must be properly attired (no hats/trousers below bottom/modest in appearance)
- 3. The Parents of the child will be invited to come to the front area for the ceremony together with their witnesses
- 4. The Parents are expected to present the child's Birth Registration Certificate
- 5. The Parents will be required to sign the Church's Dedication Certificate, a copy of which will be given at the conclusion of the Ceremony
- 6. The duration of the Ceremony is approximately 10 minutes

{Parents/Witnesses who refuse to observe the above-mentioned guidelines will be invited to leave}
