

Obituary James Lewis 1936-2017

Oldest Brother in Fellowship at the Calivigny Gospel Hall - Grenada He entered peacefully into rest on 27<sup>th</sup> May, 2017.

James Lewis was born on 14th January 1936, to Rose Bartholomew and Arthur Lewis and grew up in the village of Marian. As a child, he attended the Calivigny Gospel Hall with his family and dedicated his life to Christ in 1955, and was later baptized. Brother James often testified that he departed from the fellowship of the Assembly for about 20 years and repeatedly gave God thanks for keeping him during those wasted years. He returned to the fellowship in 1975 and continued to serve God faithfully; he is a regular praying brother and is involved in the Prison Ministry; one of the founding members of the St. Mark's Ministry and often volunteered to clean the church surroundings.

His favorite hymns are found in the Believer's Hymn Book #134; Lord Jesus I Love Thee, #315; We Sing the Praise of Him Who Died and #365; And Can It Be. He often liked to share with others the blessed assurance of Jesus Christ; 1 John 19 to 24. He enjoyed farming; e.g. burning coals even though advanced in age.
